

Public Hearing Participant Information

Denver, Colorado

August 15, 1991

The Board's Panel on Transportation & Systems (T&S Panel) will hold a public hearing from 9:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. on Thursday, August 15, 1991, at the Red Lion Hotel (formerly The Registry Hotel), Colorado Rooms 2 & 3, 3203 Quebec Street, Denver, Colorado 80207; (303) 321-3333. The purpose of the hearing is to obtain the views of persons who could be affected by the transportation of spent nuclear fuel and defense high-level waste in the event a permanent repository is located at the site currently under investigation at Yucca Mountain, Nevada. You may participate in three ways:

1. Formal Testimony

- Those wishing to present formal testimony must submit a request to the Board's Director of External Affairs by close of business, July 26, 1991. Include the following information:

(1) Name of person testifying

(2) Title, if any

(3) Name of organization, if any

(4) Telephone number

(5) Length of time desired for the presentation (the time allowed for each statement will depend on the number of people wishing to testify. You will be informed of the time allotted soon after the July 26 deadline).

(If a contact person is listed, please provide the same information for that person.)

- Submit 10 copies of testimony and any accompanying slides or other documentation to the Board for distribution to Board members by no later than August 9, 1991.

- Bring 50 additional copies to the hearing for distribution to the audience. (Contact the Director of External Affairs if this presents a problem.)

2. Walk-in, Informal Testimony

- Sign up on the day of the hearing at the Red Lion Hotel, (303) 321-3333 beginning at 9:00 A.M. Time slots will be reserved on a first-come, first-served basis. Time will be set aside during the late morning and late afternoon hours for walk-in testimony.

3. Statements for the Record

- Anyone may submit written comments in lieu of appearing before the members of the panel until November 30, 1991. Submit original statement to Chair, Panel on Transportation & Systems, NWTRB, 1100 Wilson Blvd., Suite 910, Arlington, Virginia 22209.

All participants should be prepared to answer questions from panel members. Transcripts of the hearing will be available beginning September 5, 1991, on a library-loan basis from the Board librarian.
